



REQUEST FOR CHARITABLE DONATION



CONDITIONS:

1. All requests must promote the wellbeing of East Wittering & Bracklesham residents or the fabric of the Parish.
2. Requests will not be considered from individuals, non-charitable bodies outside of East Wittering & Bracklesham or for work unrelated to the Parish.
3. Requests will not be considered from bodies from other areas of the UK unless the service they provide significantly benefits the Parish or its residents.
4. Requests should be for the following financial year and are for single donations. The Parish does not commit to continuing support and no donation or series of donations is to be taken as an indicator of future funding.
5. The sum of money requested should be commensurate to the benefit obtained by East Wittering & Bracklesham when compared to the overall activity of any organisation requesting a donation.
6. The decision of the Parish Council is final.
